
The University's Commencement ceremony will be held Sunday, May 11, at 9:30 a.m. in the JMA Wireless Dome. The ceremony will include a keynote address and the presentation of honorary degrees. Chancellor Kent Syverud and I will be part of this celebration, along with Syracuse University faculty members and Trustees.

In addition, each school and college host a convocation ceremony where all graduation candidates are individually recognized. The dean of your student's school or college leads this ceremony and, in some cases, presents awards and honors to students. A reception will be held either before or immediately after the convocation ceremony, providing you and your student with an opportunity to meet with fellow graduates and speak with faculty and staff who have been important to your student during their time at Syracuse.
