## Siddhartha Bhattacharya



Sid Bhattacharya is associate vice president (AVP) for marketing strategy in the Division of Marketing at Syracuse University. Born and raised in India, Bhattacharya earned a bachelor's degree in economics from St. Xavier's College, Calcutta in 1998. He went on to earn a master's in international economics from Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi in 2000 and an MBA from the Saunder's College of Business at the Rochester Institute of Technology (RIT) in 2002.

Bhattacharya began his career as an intern at Xerox Corporation in Rochester, NY, while completing his MBA at RIT. That experience resulted in a full-time opportunity as a Marketing Analyst at Xerox. Over 14 years at Xerox, Bhattacharya served in various marketing leadership roles and was the architect behind the launch of the 'Xerox ConnectKey Technology Ecosystem', that led to significant growth in market share and revenue for the company. As Global Director of Marketing, Sid built and managed a high performing marketing team across the world.

In 2016, Bhattacharya was recruited to become the Vice President of Global Marketing at Kodak Alaris, a spinoff from Eastman Kodak. Collaborating closely with the President of the company, Bhattacharya was instrumental in leading business, digital and cultural transformation across the organization. He was also tasked to help pivot the company from a hardware-focused to a software-led operation, including the building of a new Software as a Solution (SaaS) based cloud platform. Some of Bhattacharya's key contributions were around modernizing the marketing function at Alaris to be 'digital first,' rebranding the company with a new name and bringing to life authentic and compelling storytelling.

In late 2018, Bhattacharya joined Syracuse University to lead its first ever marketing strategy team. In his current role, he oversees a team of strategists and project managers that work with all university partners to help develop and execute upon strategic marketing plans that are tied to specific and measurable goals and audiences.

Bhattacharya is a highly competitive, enthusiastic, results driven and operational marketing professional, also serving as an inspirational leader instrumental in driving transformation across teams and organizations. He also serves on the board of directors for Visit Syracuse and lives in Fayetteville, NY with his wife Urvashi, two children, Shreya (15) and Dhruv (10). In his spare time, and when he is not driving his son across the region for soccer tournaments, he enjoys a glass of beer and watching a game of cricket.
