AFFINITY GROUPS, MY ALMA MATER DOESN'T YET HAVE CELEBRATIONS THAT GIVE GRADUATES THE SPACE TO HONOR THEIR COMMUNITIES AND COMMEMORATE THEIR UNIQUE AND ALL TOO OFTEN UNIQUELY CHALLENGING JOURNEYS AS THEY ADVANCE FROM INCOMING FRESHMEN TO ALUMNI.

THE FOUNDERS OF ITANWA ORINWA,
OUR STORY, OUR SONG, CREATED
SOMETHING TRULY SPECIAL HERE IN
2002.

TRULY SPECIAL THAT DOESN'T EXIST EVERYWHERE.

NOW, CREATING SPACES WHERE WE CAN THRIVE AND BOTH BE SEEN FULLY AND JUST BE IS SOMETHING OUR PEOPLE HAVE ALWAYS HAD TO DO.

THE SAD IRONY IS THAT THE VERY FOLKS WHO EXCLUDE US, WHO TRY TO MARGINALIZED -- [INDISCERNIBL E] -- OURS.

RIGHT?

I MEAN, WE HAD TO BUILD IT.

JUST LAST WEEK I WAS READING

INSIDE HIGHER ED, THERE WAS A

PIECE PUBLISHED TITLED

CONSERVATIVES RAIL AGAINST

SEGREGATED GRADUATIONS.

OUTLETS FROM FOX NEWS TO THE

DAILY MAIL ARE TARGETING THESE

CELEBRATIONS AS PART OF THEIR

BROADER ATTACK ON CLAIMING TO

CREATE A MORE INCLUSIVE SOCIETY.

THEY SAY THAT CEREMONIES LIKE
THIS BEAUTIFUL GATHERING,
QUOTE, CONSTRUCT ARTIFICIAL
BINARIES TO DIVIDE STUDENTS
INTO US AND THEM.

BUT WE KNOW BETTER, DON'T WE?
I KNOW BETTER.

WE KNOW THAT FAR FROM DIVIDING STUDENTS, CELEBRATIONS LIKE THIS HELP STUDENTS TO HOLD FIRM TO THEIR SENSE OF SELF, WHILE ALSO RECLAIMING YOUR HERITAGE AND TRADITIONS SO THAT THEY BECOME A LEGACY, AN INHERITANCE THAT BOLSTERS YOU LONG AFTER YOU WALK ACROSS THAT STAGE ON SUNDAY.

NOW, SHEA TALKED ABOUT MY BOOKS

AMERICANS IN MY NOVEL, SUMMER ON THE BLUFFS, WHICH IS SET ON MARTHA'S VINEYARD, SUMMER ON SAG HARBOR, WHICH JUST CAME OUT MAY 2ND, MY THIRD BOOK WILL TAKE PLACE IN HIGH LAND BEACH, MARYLAND, WHERE FREDERICK DOUGLASS WHAT HAD SUMMER HOME IN THE LATE 1800S.

WE HAVE CARVED OUT THESE SPACES FOR OURSELVES SINCE THE LATE 1800S.

NOW, WHAT MANY PEOPLE DON'T KNOW
IS THAT THEY EVEN EXISTED.
AND INTERESTINGLY ENOUGH, WHEN
I PITCHED MY IDEA TO THESE
PUBLISHING HOUSES, TWO OF THEM
TOLD ME THAT THERE WAS NO MARKET
FOR THOSE BOOKS.

THEY ALSO QUESTIONED WHETHER BLACK WOMEN READ.

SUMMER BEACH READS IN PARTICULAR.

I'M PROUD TO SAY THE SUMMER ON THE BLUFFS SOLD OVER 20,000 BOOKS IN A WEEK.

I'M PROUD TO SAY SUMMER ON SAG HARBOR JUST SOLD 11,000 BOOKS IN LESS THAN A WEEK AND IS ALSO NOW ON THE NEW YORK TIMES BEST SELLER LIST.

BECAUSE WE -- SELLER LIST.

BECAUSE WE NEED THESE SPACES.

THESE SPACES ARE KNOWN NOW AS

HISTORICALLY BLACK BEACHFRONT

COMMUNITIES.

THERE'S A NAME FOR THEM.
HBBCS.

IT'S A FEDERAL DESIGNATION.

ISN'T THAT GREAT?

THESE COMMUNITIES DIDN'T BEGIN

THAT WAY.

LAWYERS, DOCTORS, NURSES,
TEACHERS, ENGINEERS, CIVIL
SERVANTS, NONE OF WHOM COULD GET
LOANS FROM WHITE-RUN BANKS,
JOINED FORCES TO UNDERWRITE
MORTGAGES THAT ALLOWED THEM TO
PAY FOR THEIR HOMES SLOWLY, SOME
BEGINNING WITH JUST \$100 DOWN
PAYMENT.

INSTEAD OF SENDING THEIR

CHILDREN TO SUMMER CAMP, WE WERE EXCLUDED FROM THOSE TOO, BY THE WAY, PARENTS INVESTED IN PROPERTY, LITTLE BY LITTLE, YEAR BY YEAR.

THE NEW YORK TIMES MAGAZINE
DOING MY RESEARCH I FOUND
REPORTED IN THE 1950S AND '60S,
SOME OF SAG HARBOR'S FIRST BLACK
HOMEOWNERS BOUGHT KITS FOR
GABLED ROOF AND WRAP AROUND
PORCHES FROM SERIES CATALOGS
AND THEN ASSEMBLED THEM WITH
HELP FROM FRIENDS.

I SEE SOME OF YOU ALL LOOKING AT ME LIKE WHAT IS SERIES ROEBUCK.

ASK YOUR PARENTS ABOUT THE SEARS

CATALOG AT THE RECEPTION.

I KNOW THERE'S SOMEONE HERE

UNDER THREAT, I'M SAD TO REPORT.

BANKS THAT WOULDN'T LOAN TO

BLACK FAMILIES THEN ARE NOW

POURING MONEY INTO DEVELOPMENT

PROJECTS THAT WILL RAZE

HISTORIC HOMES IN THESE

COMMUNITIES TO MAKE WAY FOR

LARGER, MODERN HOUSES THAT WILL

ALMOST CERTAINLY BE BOUGHT BY

AND WHILE THEY MIGHT SEEM
DIFFERENT, THE FIGHTS, BLACK
FAMILIES MUST WAGE TO HOLD ONTO
LAND THE FIGHTS BLACK AND BROWN
STUDENTS AT PREDOMINANTLY WHITE
INSTITUTIONS MUST WAGE TO HOLD
ONTO THE SACRED SPACES YOU HAVE
CREATED HERE, THEY'RE ACTUALLY
CONNECTED IN MY VIEW.

WHITE FAMILIES.

BECAUSE BOTH ARE SAD REMINDERS
THAT OUR SOCIETY CONTINUES TO BE
TRACKED IN CYCLES OF PROGRESS
AND PUNISHMENT, BREAKTHROUGH
AND BACKLASH OR AS I LIKE TO SAY,
BLACK LASH, SINCE WE HAD A BLACK
PRESIDENT, A MAN ABOVE REPROACH
OF EXCELLENCE AND THEN WE GOT
THE ORANGE MAN.

SO THE -- THE -- HE WHO SHALL NOT BE MENTIONED.

AND THE FUNNY THING IS THAT IT
SEEMS THAT THERE WAS FAR TOO
LITTLE PROGRESS AND
BREAKTHROUGH IN THE LAST CYCLE,
YET WE'RE FACING MASSIVE
PUNISHMENT TODAY.

FIGHTS OVER WHETHER WE'RE GOING
TO BE A NATION THAT EMBRACES AND
CELEBRATES EVERYONE'S HUMANITY
OR A NATION THAT CONTINUES TO
DEHUMANIZE AND DEGRADE ANYONE
WHO ISN'T WHITE MALE CISGENDER
AND STRAIGHT.

NOW, THOSE FIGHTS AREN'T ONLY ON THE NEWS, THEY'VE ALSO HIT CLOSE TO HOME, I LEARNED.

THE WORLD WHAT YOU DID HERE.

CREATING A RENAISSANCE,

CULTIVATING A REVIVAL.

IT'S CONSTRUCTING A REBIRTH.

I BELIEVE THAT YOUR GENERATION,

EVEN THOUGH MY CHILDREN SCARE

ME, IS GOING TO TAKE US INTO A

FUTURE WHERE THE OLD

DEFINITIONS AND BATTLES FADE

AWAY.

I BELIEVE THAT TRULY IN MY SOUL.

A FUTURE WHERE LOVE SPEAKS MORE

LOUDLY THAN HATE.

AND WHERE EMPATHY AND

GENEROSITY HOLD SWAY, NOT

BIGOTRY AND BIAS.

I SEE IT IN ABOUT MY CHILDREN AND

HOW THEY APPROACH ALL THE FIGHTS
AND CONTROVERSIES THAT IDENTIFY
OUTLINED, BECAUSE FOR ME,
SOMETIMES I WANT TO MEET ENERGY
WITH ENTERING.

IF YOU GO LOW I WANT TO BECOME SMALL LIKE AN ANT AND GO TO THE EARTH'S CRUST.

MY CHILDREN, THEY DON'T DO THAT.

I THINK THAT YOUR IMAGINATION,
WHICH HAS BEEN SUPER CHARGED BY
YOUR EXPERIENCES WITH
TECHNOLOGY AND MEDIA OF EVERY
KIND IS MATCHED BY YOUR COURAGE

BE TOTALLY PRESENT, MAXIMIZE
YOUR POWER, DECIDE WHO YOU WILL

TIMES MANY MY CAREER, REPORTING

ON THE MURDER OF TRAYVON

MARTIN -- [INDISCERNIBLE] -
PRETENDING TO SOUND LIKE

SOLODAD O'BRIEN, I BLEW OUT MY

HAIR TO LOOK LIKE HER, I SPOKE

LIKE SOLODAD O'BRIEN, BECAUSE I

FELT THAT THAT WAS WHAT WAS

ACCEPTABLE.

NOW, I WAS HONORED TO BE THE FIRST NATIONAL REPORTER TO COVER AND STAY ON THAT STORY.

BECAUSE BEN KRUMP IS MY FRIEND AND HE CALLED ME WITH IT AND HE GAVE IT TO ME AND HE TRUSTED ME WITH IT, I WAS ALSO HONORED TO BE INVITED TO SU.

IT SHOULD BE SAID I BELIEVE HAS
THE BEST JOURNALISM SCHOOL IN
THE COUNTRY, TO SPEAK ABOUT THE
RESPONSIBILITY WE HAVE AS
JOURNALISTS DURING TIMES OF
NATIONAL CRISIS.

I WAS JOINED BY TWO MOTHERS OF
THE MOVEMENT, MY NOW FRIEND
TRAYVON'S MOTHER AND MICHAEL
BROWN'S MOTHER AS WELL OF COURSE

AS BEN KRUMP AND MY THEN CNN COLLEAGUE.

AND AS I TOLD THE AUDIENCE THAT NIGHT IN GOLDSTEIN AUDITORIUM, I HAD TO FIGHT WITH MY PRODUCERS JUST TO GET CLEARANCE TO TRAVEL TO SANFORD, FLORIDA, FOR THE TRIAL.

THE SAD FACT IS CNN WASN'T

MAKING A JOURNALISM CALL, THEY

WERE MAKING A BUSINESS

DECISION.

I WAS TOLD THAT REPORTING A
BLACK BOY'S MURDER BY A
VIGILANTE WOULD NOT GET THEM
RATINGS BECAUSE IT WAS A LOCAL
STORY THAT HAPPENED ALL THE
TIME.

THAT'S WHAT I WAS TOLD.

IT'S HEARTBREAKING ACTUALLY TO

EVEN SAY IT OUT LOUD.

BUT THAT'S WHAT I WAS TOLD.

EVEN AFTER I WAS ABLE TO

CONVINCE THEM TO SEND ME TO

FLORIDA WITH ANDERSON COOPER

PAYING FOR IT, THEY EVENTUALLY

PULLED MY CLEARANCE, TELLING ME
THAT I HAD GOTTEN TOO CLOSE TO
THE FAMILY.

THE TRUTH OF THE MATTER IS, THAT

IT HAD BECOME A NATIONAL STORY

AND THEY WANTED BIGGER NAMES ON

IT.

AND IT'S INTERESTING HOW THAT
STANDARD OF FALSE OBJECTIVITY
IS ONLY EVER APPLIED TO
REPORTERS OF COLOR, ISN'T IT?
I'M CATHOLIC, YET I'VE NEVER
BEEN PULLED FROM A CATHOLIC
CHURCH SCANDAL BECAUSE I'M TOO
CLOSE TO IT.

EVER.

REPORTERS ARE SUPPOSED TO GET CLOSE BECAUSE WE NEED ACCESS.

AND IN MY VIEW, AS A MOTHER OF A BLACK SON, AND A LAWYER, AND A FORMER PROSECUTOR, THOSE ARE MY SUPER POWERS.

NO ONE ELSE CAN GIVE THE VIEWERS THAT PERSPECTIVE.

SO WHAT DID I DO?
WHEN THEY PULLED ME?

LIKE YOU, CLASS OF 2023, I BECAME CREATIVE.

I STAYED IN FLORIDA ON MY OWN DIME.

I TOOK OUT A LOAN.

BECAUSE BET COULDN'T FOOT THE
BILL FOR THEIR REPORTERS TO STAY
ON THE GROUND, I BORROWED THEIR
PRESS PASS, SO I COULD REPORT
FROM THE COURTROOM.

AND WHEN BET COULDN'T GIVE ME A
PASS, I BORE REED TELEMUNDO'S
PASS, THE AFRO-LATINA THING
WORKED OUT FOR ME.

I CALLED HOME EVERY EVENING, AND AFTER I TOLD THEM GOODNIGHT, I WOULD WORK INTO THE EARLY HOURS FIGHTING BACK TEARS AND RESOLVING TO NOT BACK DOWN UNTIL MY JOB WAS DONE.

EVEN IF IT MEANT PUTTING MY

FUTURE AT RISK AT CNN, I TOLD THE

STORY WITH THE CARE,

INTELLIGENCE, AND INSIGHT THAT

THAT ALL OF OUR STORIES DESERVE.

MY FATHER THOUGH WHO IS FROM GEORGIA CALLED AND SAID, BABY GIRL, YOU'RE DOING THAT JOB BUT YOU'RE GOING TO LOSE YOUR JOB.

I DID NOT LOSE MY JOB.

I WAS AFRAID ALL THE TIME, BUT

I WASN'T AFRAID OF ANYTHING.

AND I GOT AN REMY FOR SOME OF THAT -- EMMY FOR SOME OF THAT REPORTING.

NOW, THINK THAT LIVING FULLY IN THE PRESENT LIKE DR. ANGELOU ENCOURAGES IS THE ONLY WAY TO CREATE THE FUTURE I ALLUDED TO EARLIER, THE ONE I KNOW YOU'RE GOING TO FORGE, CLASS OF 2023. THE PAST IS SHUT TO US, UNFORTUNATELY WE HAVE NO POWER TO CHANGE OR REWRITE IT, AND THE TRAGIC FACT REALLY IS THAT OUR HISTORY IS BEING ERASED. WE ARE EXPERIENCING WHAT I AM DESIGNATING A PAPER GENOCIDE. THEY CALL IT ANTIWOKE AND ANTICRITICAL RACE THEORY, BUT REALLY IT IS A CONCERTED EFFORT

TO ERASE OUR HISTORY AND OUR ACCOMPLISHMENTS.

BECAUSE AS OUR ANCESTORS KNOW,
WE BUILT THIS JOINT FOR FREE, WE
BUILT THIS COUNTRY ON OUR BACKS
FOR FREE.

AND WE HAVE TO CONFRONT THAT.

WE ALSO NEED TO ACCEPT THAT THE

FUTURE IS BEYOND OUR CONTROL,

DESPITE WHAT YOU THINK IT WILL

ARRIVE ON ITS OWN TIME IN ITS OWN

WAY DOING ITS OWN THING, OUR

TASK IS TO DEVOTE OURSELVES

FULLY IN HERE AND NOW.

WE HAVE ONE PRECIOUS LIFE AND

DR. ANGELOU'S WORDS ARE A

REMINDER TO NOT MISS A SECOND OF

IT.

NOW, THIS -- THIS I THINK IS
REALLY IMPORTANT, MAXIMIZING
YOUR POWER IN THE ROOM.
BEING FULLY PRESENT WILL
TRANSFORM HOW YOU MOVE IN ROOMS.
IT WILL TRANSFORM HOW YOU MOVE
IN THE WORLD.

IT WILL ALSO DETERMINE HOW YOU

MOVE WITHIN SPACES OF POWER,
SPACES THAT YOU WILL FIND
YOURSELF IN SHORTLY.

HOW MANY OF YOU BELIEVE IT'S IMPORTANT TO BE IN THE ROOM WHERE IT HAPPENS?

NOT ENOUGH.

THIS GATHERING THOUGH IS PROOF
OF HOW IMPORTANT IT IS FOR US TO
CREATE OUR OWN SPACES.

I WILL TELL YOU MY FRIEND CARLA HARRIS, I DON'T KNOW IF MANY OF YOU KNOW HER, SHE WAS APPOINTED BY PRESIDENT BARACK OBAMA TO CHAIR THE NATIONAL WOMEN'S BUSINESS COUNCIL, TOLD ME SOMETHING ONE DAY YEARS AGO AS I STARTED MY CAREER, THAT STOPPED ME IN MY TRACKS.

SO WHAT DOES THAT MEAN?

IT MEANS YOU NEED A CHAMPION IN

THE ROOM.

IT MEANS THAT WE NEED CHAMPIONS
IN THE ROOMS, THE ROOMS OF
GOVERNMENT, OF BUSINESS, OF
ACADEMIA, WHERE DECISIONS ARE
BEING MADE THAT AFFECT US AND
OUR PEOPLE AND OUR COMMUNITIES.
NOW, BECAUSE OF THIS COUNTRY'S
LONG HISTORY OF DISCRIMINATION,
THAT CHAMPION IN MANY OF THESE
ROOMS OFTEN DO NOT LOOK LIKE US.
WE'RE SO LUCKY IF THE PERSON

DOES, AND SHARES OUR LIVED EXPERIENCES.

LET'S SAY THE PERSON DOES LOOK LIKE YOU.

HE OR SHE NEEDS TO HAVE

POLITICAL POWER TO MAKE A

DIFFERENCE IN YOUR CAREER AND IN

YOUR LIFE.

BUT MORE IMPORTANTLY, THEY MUST
ALSO CHOOSE TO SPEND THAT
POLITICAL POWER ON YOU.

AND TOO OFTEN IN MY EXPERIENCE
WE THINK THERE ISN'T SPACE FOR
ANOTHER PERSON WHO LOOKS LIKE US
TO BE IN THAT ROOM.

WE THINK THERE'S ONLY PLACE IN OUR SPACE FOR ONE.

SYRACUSE, I ASSURE YOU, THERE IS ROOM FOR ALL OF US.

THERE IS ROOM.

NOT ONLY IS THERE ROOM FOR MORE
OF US WHEN WE BRING OUR PEOPLE
INTO THE ROOM IT'S STRENGTHENS
OUR POLITICAL CAPITAL.

IT HAS A MULTIPLIER EFFECT,
ALLOWING US TO BE ABLE TO BRING

MORE AND MORE OF OUR PEOPLE INSIDE.

DO YOU KNOW WHY I KNOW THIS?

BECAUSE I WASN'T IN A ROOM WHEN
A DISCUSSION WAS BEING HAD ABOUT
MY UPCOMING CONTRACT AT ABC.

AND THE SENIOR VICE PRESIDENT OF
TALENT SAID AND WAS CAUGHT ON
TAPE SAYING, WELL, SUNNY IS FROM
THE BRONX PROJECTS, SHE'S LOW
RENT.

WE DON'T HAVE TO PAY HER WHAT WE HAVE TO PAY THE OTHERS.

FOR FIVE YEARS I WAS THE
LOWEST-PAID ANCHOR AND HOST ON
THE VIEW, BECAUSE SHE THOUGHT I
WASN'T IN THE ROOM, BUT I HAD A
CHAMPION IN THE ROOM WITH A
VOICE RECORDER.

AND NOW I'M NOT ONLY IN THE ROOM,
I ALSO LEAD THE ROOM WITH MY
PRODUCTION COMPANY SUNNY HOSTIN
PRODUCTIONS, WHICH IS A
DISNEY-BACKED COMPANY BECAUSE I
ASKED FOR REPARATIONS.

AND I WILL TELL YOU, A LOT OF OUR

PEOPLE IN THE ROOM WITH ME NOW.

AND WE ARE SO STRONG TOGETHER.

I REALIZED FROM THAT REALLY HARD

TIME IN MY LIFE IT WAS PROBABLY

ONE OF THE FIRST TIMES I RECALL

CRYING AS AN ADULT, ALONE WE

SURVIVE, WE KNOW THAT, BUT

TOGETHER WE THRIVE.

WE ARE STRONG AS A FAMILY WE THRIVE.

NOW, THE PROPER VERB THAT GOD HAS FOR ME IT IS FOR ME IS ONE OF MY FAVORITES.

WHAT GOD HAS FOR ME, IT IS FOR ME.

AND IT'S A MESSAGE THAT'S

MINISTERED TO ME THROUGH SOME OF

MY MOST CHALLENGING DAYS.

WHAT GOD HAS FOR ME IT IS FOR ME.

SOMETIMES WHEN WE HAVE TO WORK

HARDER THAN EVERYONE ELSE FOR

EACH ADVANCE AND INCREASE WE

FEEL PRESSURE TO HOLD ON

ESPECIALLY TIGHT, BUT I WANT YOU

TO FEEL -- I DON'T WANT YOU TO

FEEL LIKE YOU HAVE TO HOLD ON SO

TIGHTLY.

NO ONE CAN BLOCK WHAT GOD HAS ORDAINED, NO ONE CAN TAKE WHAT GOD HAS GIVEN YOU.

AND LET ME SAY IT EVEN MORE
PLAINLY: MANY OF YOU SILTING
HERE IN THIS AUDIENCE HAVE
DREAMS.

THEY SEEM SOME WHAT UNATTAINABLE.

YOU TELL THEM TO MAYBE YOUR
FAMILY AND YOUR FRIENDS AND THEY
SAY THINGS LIKE, OH, THAT'S
INTERESTING.

THEY DON'T UNDERSTAND YOUR DREAM.

SOME OF THEM WILL EVEN TRY

COMPETE WITH YOU FOR YOUR DREAM.

SOME OF THEM WILL NOT SUPPORT

YOUR DREAM.

THEY WILL TRY TO DISSUADE YOU FROM YOUR DREAMS.

THEY MAY EVEN TRY TO TAKE THEM FROM YOU.

BUT DO NOT BE AFRAID.

THE DREAM WAS NOT MEANT FOR

THEM, IT WAS MEANT FOR YOU.

WHAT GOD HAS FOR YOU IT IS FOR YOU.

NOW, WHEN YOU GET INTO THESE
ROOMS OF INFLUENCE AND IMPACT
AND YOU WILL BECAUSE THIS IS
SYRACUSE UNIVERSITY AFTER ALL,
THE WAY TO MAXIMIZE YOUR POWER
IS BY BRINGING MORE AND MORE
PEOPLE INTO THESE SPACES BEHIND
YOU.

SO THE WAY TO RESPOND TO A
HISTORY OF EXCLUSION IS NOT TO
BECOME A GATEKEEPER.
PLEASE DON'T BECOME A

GATEKEEPER.

THE WAY TO RESPOND IS BY BEING EACH OTHER'S CHAMPION, BEING EACH OTHER'S CONNECTION, BEING EACH OTHER'S BOND, SO MANY PEOPLE HAVE MADE A SPACE FOR YOU TO BE IN THIS INCREDIBLE ROOM WHERE IT HAPPENS.

SO WHEN YOU LEAVE SYRACUSE TO I
DIDN'T YOUR NEXT CHAPTER I
IMPLORE YOU AND HOPE THAT YOU

WILL COMMIT TO NOT JUST PUSHING THAT DOOR OPEN, BUT HOLDING IT OPEN, EVEN IF IT'S WITH YOUR FOOT, BOTH IN THE ROOM AND MAKE OTHERS -- MAKE ROOM FOR OTHERS TO FOLLOW YOU.

AND FINALLY, WE'VE TALKED ABOUT THE IMPORTANCE OF LIFTING AS WE CLIMB, WE TALKED ABOUT THE POWER OF BEING TOTALLY PRESENT.
